### **DAIRY SHOW 2012**

- **The copies of the pedigrees of the animals that will be listed in the catalogue should arrive not later than January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012 (Fax n° +39.0458780912).**
- Animals must arrive no later than **6:00 p.m.** on **Wednesday, February 1<sup>st</sup>** and must remain on fair grounds until 6:00 p.m. of Sunday, February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012.
- **The Exhibition will take place on Friday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>, according to the following program:**

- The catalogue will be published by A.N.A.F.I. and the animals will be divided into the following Sections and Categories:

#### **Subdivision of the Sections:**

1<sup>st</sup> Section: Heifer Calves and Heifers from 6 to 26 months.

3<sup>rd</sup> Section: Heifer Cows up to 48 months of age.

4<sup>th</sup> Section: Mature Cows 4 years and older.

#### **Subdivision of the Categories:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Category: Heifer Calves from 6 to 9 months
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Category: Heifer Calves from 9 to 12 months
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Category: Heifer Calves from 12 to 15 months
- 4<sup>th</sup> Category: Heifer Calves from 15 to 18 months
- 5<sup>th</sup> Category: Heifers from 18 to 22 months
- 6<sup>th</sup> Category: Heifers from 22 to 26 months
- 8<sup>th</sup> Category: Cows 2 years old Junior (up to 30 months)
- 9<sup>th</sup> Category: Cows 2 years old Senior (from 30 to 36 months)
- 10<sup>th</sup> Category: Cows 3 years old Junior (from 36 to 42 months)
- 11<sup>th</sup> Category: Cows 3 years old Senior (from 42 to 48 months with at least 2 calvings)
- 12<sup>th</sup> Category: Cows 4 years old (from 48 to 60 months)
- 13<sup>th</sup> Category: Cows 5 years old (from 60 to 72 months)
- 14<sup>th</sup> Category: Cows 6 years and over (over 72 months)

- The reference date for the calculation of the age of the subjects is February 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- The regulations applied are those of the Italian National Holstein Association (ANAFI).
- Each animal must be accompanied by the original pedigree, their ancestry check 's certificate, and their sanitary certificate. The number on the identification tag must be clearly legible and it must correspond to the number written on the document.
- For all subjects two generations are obligatory (even for those born in Italy).
- A commission will be named to monitor the correct application of the Rules and Regulations.
- Upon your arrival on fair grounds, you will be required to complete the documentation regarding the "Code of Ethics", as a condition to be able to take part in the Exhibition.
- "Premier Breeder" and "Premier Exhibitor" awards.
- There will be prizes of recognition for the champions.
- **The Judge will be Mr. Justin Burdette (U.S.A).**

#### **Services Provided:**

- **Meals for Exhibitors:** Exhibitors will be provided 2 meal tickets per day (inside Pavilion n.9), for 2 people up to 5 animals presented, for 3 people if 6 or more animals participating in the Exhibition.
- **Reimbursement :**  
It is foreseen a reimbursement for milking cow and young cattle presented in the Exhibition

#### **Breeder's Expenses:**

- **Registration fee:** The catalogue registration fee is 10 Euros per subject enrolled.
- **Hay:** Paid directly to the supplier.
- **Sleeping :** for bad you have to pay € 20,00 for night


